

EEA Relocation : January to June 2022



342 beneficiaries relocated in the European Economic Area (EEA) from 01 January to 30 June 2022



7 EEA countries received relocated beneficiaries from 01 January to 30 June 2022



Relocations decreased significantly compared to same period in 2021 (2,213 persons assisted)

IOM's support in Relocation




In the first half of 2022, relocation reached a total of **342 relocated beneficiaries from Greece, Malta and Italy to 7 EEA countries.**

IOM, together with **involved governments and partner agencies** such as **UNHCR, UNICEF and EUAA**, coordinated and implemented **regional relocation projects funded by DG HOME**, namely RELITA (Italy), REMA (Malta) and Voluntary Relocation (Greece), allowing for more harmonized procedures in the EEA. Other relocation projects were funded by EU Member States.

IOM relocation support included the implementation of **pre-migration health activities, pre-departure orientation sessions, movement management and accommodation** (in Greece). In addition, by continuing to adopt a range of preventive measures to minimize the risk of COVID-19 transmission during movements and pre-departure activities, IOM ensured the safe and dignified relocation of the beneficiaries to EEA receiving countries.

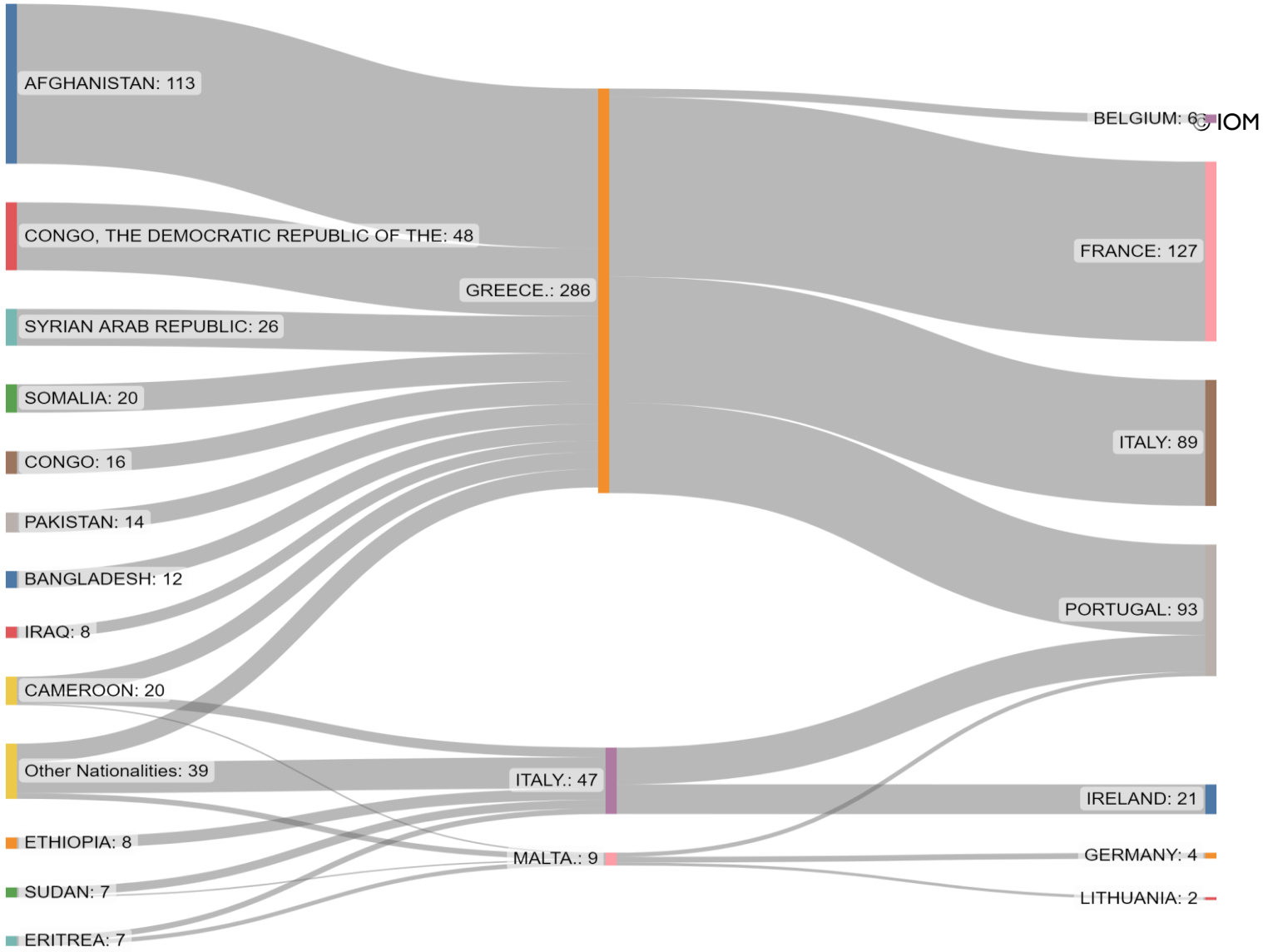

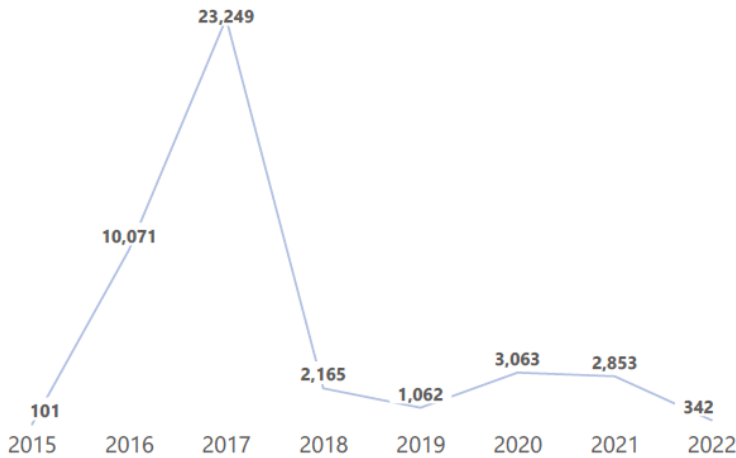
